SOLID WASTE IS COLLECTED ONCE A WEEK THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

Yardwaste can be placed at curbside on your regular trash day. Items must be cut in 4' sections and bundled/contained in container.

Burnable Bulk Items can be placed at curbside on your regular trash day. You do not need to schedule with the Township. Burnable examples: sofa, mattress*, boxspring*, cabinets, etc. NO electronics.

*MUST BE COVERED IN PLASTIC

Metal Bulk Items must be scheduled with the Township. Metal examples: bedframe, washer, dryer, refrigerator, grill, etc.

The Township no longer collects televisions and are not recyclable. Please do not put out for trash or recycles. Contact Retrievr for disposal.

Recycling will be collected on your regular trash day on a bi-weekly basis. Everything goes loose in the container. Soiled items are not recyclable. For example: dirty diapers, medical waste, used paper plates, napkins, tissues. Pizza boxes are also not recyclable. Please place all soiled items in your regular trash. Cardboxes are recycle. Do not place in regular trash. Waxed coated boxes (cereal boxes, beverages cartons, etc) are also not recyclable.
