### HOLIDAY COLLECTIONS

### LEAF COLLECTION



*Leaves will be collected weekly on your recycle day starting Oct 30th through Dec 5th. Leaves must be in biodegradable bags. Plastic bags nor loose leaves will not be accepted.*

### CHRISTMAS TREES

*Trees will be collected Jan 3rd, 9th, 10th and Dec 26th on your scheduled recycle day.*



*Trees must be free of tinsel, ornaments, lights, etc.*

### YARDWASTE

Yardwaste will be collected biweekly on Monday opposite week of Bulk Metal Collection. In addition, there will be a drop off April 8 & May 6, 9AM-12PM, Township Complex, 8500 Furey Rd.

Yardwaste must be bundled or placed loosely in a container. Grass clippings are not to be placed out with yardwaste but disposed of in regular trash



### MEDICAL WASTE DISPOSAL

Radioactive waste from patients treated with Radioactive Iodine-131 and other isotopes has repeatedly ended up in the waste stream. As refuse is taken to different facilities for processing, it is screened for radioactivity thru portal monitors while it is still in garbage trucks. The screening is based on a regulatory requirement and is meant to identify high level and industrial sources of radiation. Any articles or items with body fluid on them may set off a radiation alarm at the local sanitation solid waste processing sites.

Please follow all the directions from your medical provider. The radioiodine will exit the body by way of the urine, stool, perspiration, saliva, and blood. Please do not put soiled products into your household trash. The directions from your medical provider could include holding soiled waste in an isolated area, bringing the soiled items back to the healthcare facility where you received your treatment. You may also notify the Township at 484-483-7215. By notifying the Township, the Sanitation crews will collect the medical waste at the end of the day and keep isolated for proper disposal.

### BULK TRASH ITEMS

**M Metals** – collected biweekly on Monday, opposite of Yardwaste. If a holiday falls on Monday, the bulk item will be collected next scheduled bulk day. Residents are required to schedule for this collection by calling the Township at 484.483.7215 by noon Friday prior.

**Burnable** – collected weekly on your regular trash day. Simply place item(s) curbside. Two (2) items max per week. No Electronics.

- No single item may weigh more than 25 lbs
- Carpets and pads must be cut and rolled into 4" wide rolls not to exceed 25 lbs per roll. Ten rolls will constitute a single bulk item.
- Bulk collections do not include construction, demolition, or renovation debris, or any commercial trash. Residents will need to make private hauling arrangements to dispose of these items.
